Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

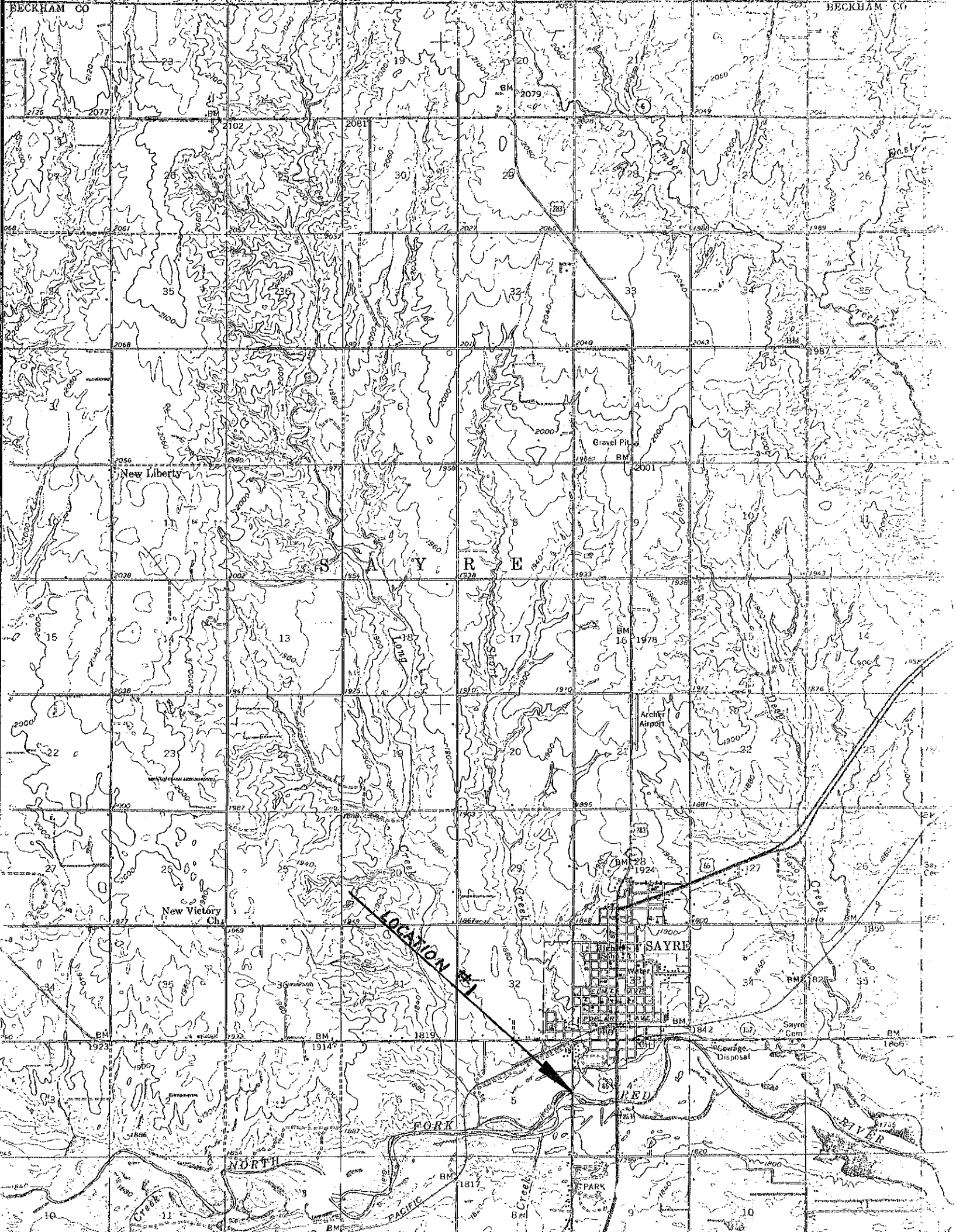
