This is to advise that the high water in the Beaver fork of the N. Canadian got out of its bank enough to cross over the M.K.T. Ry tracks and flood U.S. 270 and S. H. #3 in the northeast corner of Ellis County, for over one half mile.

The Highwater mark on the 90' I-Beam span on S. A. P. 792 at Station 856 + 75 to 857 + 75 was 1.5' above the floor of the bridge
