The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

Explanatory Remarks Highwater stopped traffic for some time at this location but most of water came from ditch water from north and south and not so much from the 2-8x6 R.C.B. flooding over. Local resident said water came down the highway from the north approx. 1 1/2 feet in depth in places.
