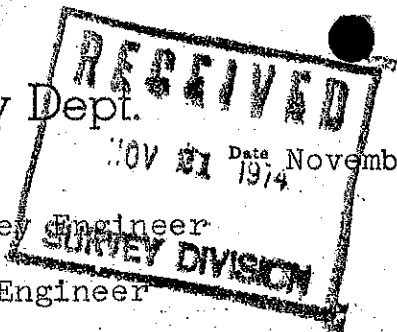

### Additional Highwater information on Quick Sand Branch Sta. 103 + 52

Mrs. Ruth Biggs has lived in the House Lt of Sta. 101 for the past 18 years. She states that the water was crossing the road at Sta 102 + 50 elevation = 554.0.

Mr. Carl Cole lived 11 years in the House Lt of Sta 110 but presently lives in Stigler, stated he has seen the water between 20 inches and 2 feet deep across the road this would be elev. 552.5. This information was also agreeded to by Mr. Freeman Going who owns a Farm in the area and travels the road daily. Mr. Cole and Mr. Going were together when this information was obtained from them. They both agreeded the driving surface of the bridge had not been under water that it was about 1/2 foot above the water this would be 552.6.

Mr. Euel Renfrow was not at Home so the information originally obtained from him could not be verified.

### Additional Highwater information on Taloka Creek Sta 130 + 95

Mr. Thomas Cooper lives in the House Lt of Sta 139 has lived in the area for 34 years. He stated that the deepest he had seen the water across the road was between 1/2 to 3/4 feet. El. 541.8

Mr. Freeman Going who owns a farm in the area stated that the deepest He had seen the water at Taloka Creek was between 3/4 to 1.0 feet. Elev. = 541.8

The Lady that lives in the House Lt of Sta 120 + would not say how deep the water was over the road but that it had been over the road but cars could still go through. She also said it had washed out their fence.

All persons listed on both Quick Sand Branch and Taloka Creek said the water would get to their elevation approximately once in two or three years but they had seen it their several times.
