FLOOD INFORMATION FORM

To be used in obtaining and transmitting flood water elevations for Survey Division office record files. This information to be obtained by all Chiefs of Party or others in their vicinity in times of unusual high water, or at any time available from a reliable source. The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

Was highwater mark obtained from actual water, drift, local resident, U. S. Engineers, etc.? MARK USED WAS DRIFT ON WEST SIDE OF DUCK CREEK (NEW CHANNEL). WATER HAD APPARENTLY GROSSED DYKE IN SEVERAL PLACES BUT JUST REACHED THE TOP OF DYKE IN VICINITY OF SURVEY CENTERLINE. TOP OF DYKE ELEV FROM FILE NOTES WAS USED.

Explanatory Remarks ON OCT. 2, 1961 R.O. CARTMILL & O.C. CURNUTT CHECKED THE ABOVE INFORMATION BY TAKING SHOTS ON DRIFT IN FENCES LT. OF SURVEY CENTERLINE AT STA. 406 TO 408 OF THIS SURVEY WHERE CENTERLINE GROSSES THE OLD CHANNEL OF DUCK CREEK. HIGHWATER ELEVATIONS WERE IDENTICAL IN BOTH PLACES. LANDOWNER R.A. ROTHGEB WHO HAS LIVED FOR 37 YEARS APPROX. 1.5 MI. W. OF DUCK CREEK & APPROX 700' SOUTH OF US 60 SAID THIS WAS AN EXTREME HIGHWATER. ALL ABOVE INFORMATION OBTAINED BY R.O. CARTMILL & O.C. CURNUTT.

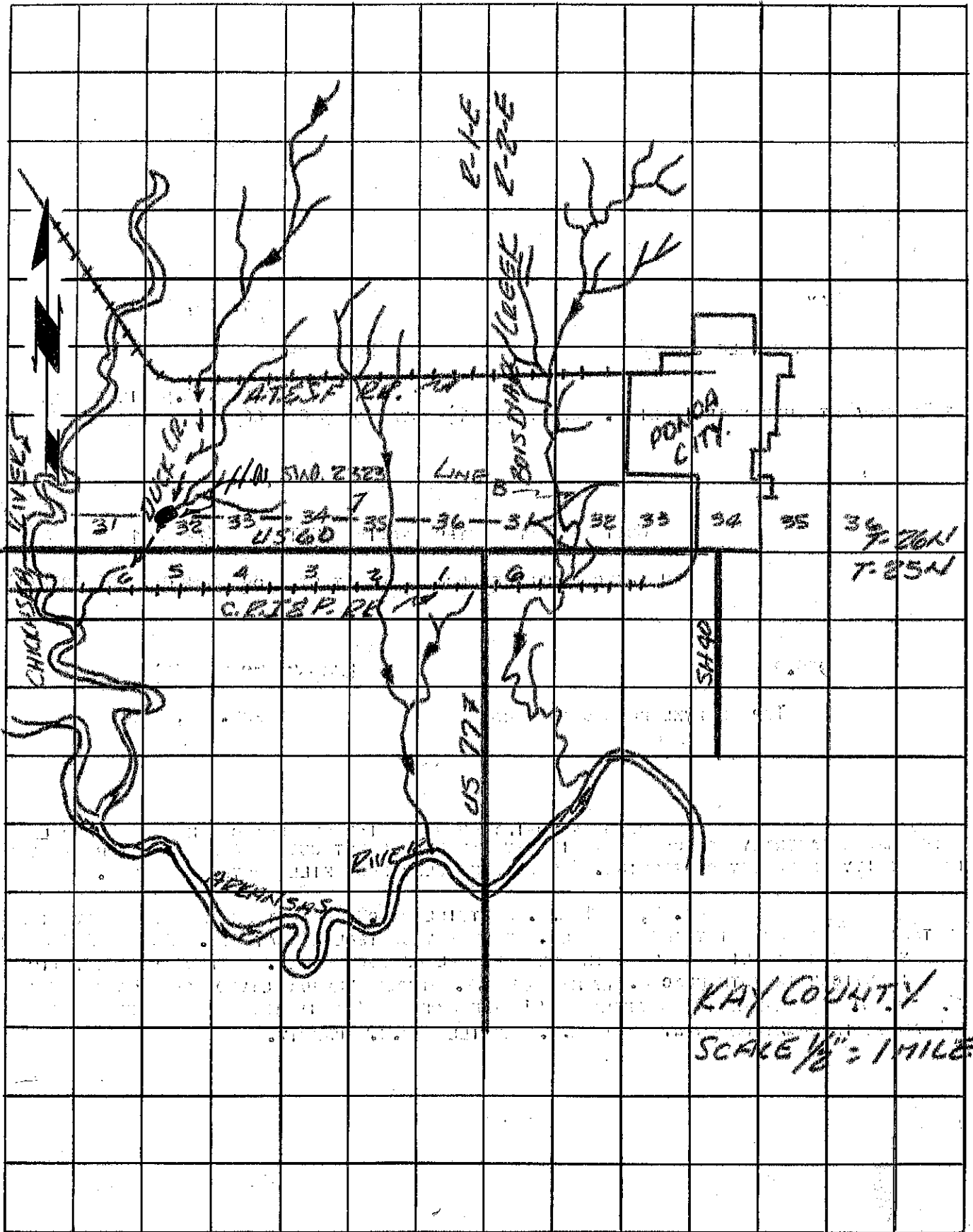
