1. Location KINGFISHER, OKLAHOMA. 316' WEST AND 47' NORTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF ROBERTS AVENUE AND MAIN STREET (US 81) TO WATER MARK ACROSS WHITE OVERHEAD DOOR OF QUALITY LANUDRY ON NORTH SIDE OF ROBERTS AVENUE.
2. Subject EXTREME HIGHWATER IN KINGFISHER CRESTED AT 11:30 A.M. MAY 17, 1982. HIGHWATER WAS FROM KINGFISHER CREEK.
3. Purpose NOTE: THIS HIGHWATER WAS CAUSED FROM 4.5 INCHES OF RAIN THAT FELL ON SUNDAY MAY 16, 1982 ON TOP OF 3 TO 4 INCHES WHICH FELL EARLIER CAUSING FLOODING ON US 81 AND THE EVACUATION OF APPROXIMATELY 400 TO 600 PEOPLE.

5. History and Explanations HIGHWATER REACHED CREST STAGE AT 11:30A.M. MAY 17, 1982. CREST ELEVATION 1044.5 ALONG MAIN ST (US 81) AT "A" AVENUE AND "B" AVENUE.
