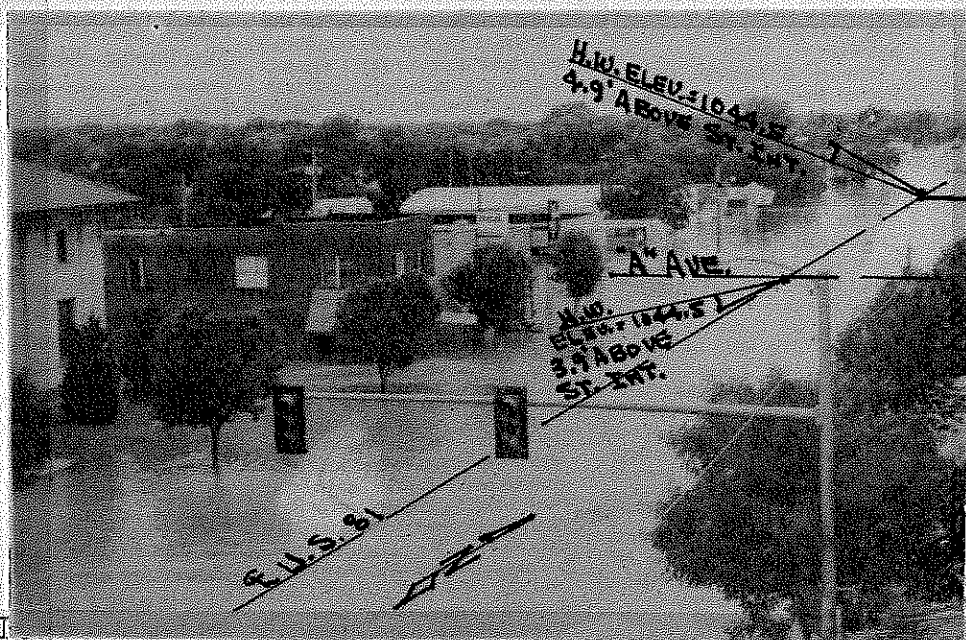

THAT FELL ON SUNDAY MAY 16, 1982 ON TOP OF 3 TO 4 INCHES OF RAIN
WHICH FELL EARLIER CAUSING FLOODING ON U.S. 18 AND EVACUATION
OF APPROXIMATELY 400 TO 600 PEOPLE.
