The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

Elevation obtained from silt marks on trees and drifts, Present SH 112 was closed to traffic for a few hours. Two feet of water over highway bridge.
