FLOOD INFORMATION FORM

To be used in obtaining and transmitting flood water elevations for Plans & Survey office record files. This information to be obtained by all Chiefs of Party in their vicinity in times of unusual high water, or at any time available from a reliable source. The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

Highway number SH 74 Name of stream Cottonwood Creek

Direction and distance from nearest town, village or store 6 1/2 miles south of Jct. SH 74 & SH 33, or 9 miles west and 7 miles south of Guthrie, Okla. On SH 74 at Cottonwood Creek Bridge.

Section, Township and Range Between Sections 13 & 14, T 15 N, R 4 W.

Description of Location Bridge at Cottonwood Creek, 6 1/2 miles south of Jct. SH 74 & SH 33 on SH 74.

Method obtained Hand Level & Philadelphia Rod.

Elevation 3.5 feet lower than Bridge Source of levels floor at south end of bridge.

Was highwater mark obtained from actual water, drift, local resident, U. S. Engineers, etc? High water was obtained from actual high water.

Explanatory Remarks The rain in this drainage area was extremely spotted, but the rain fall was from 3 to 7 inches in this drainage area.

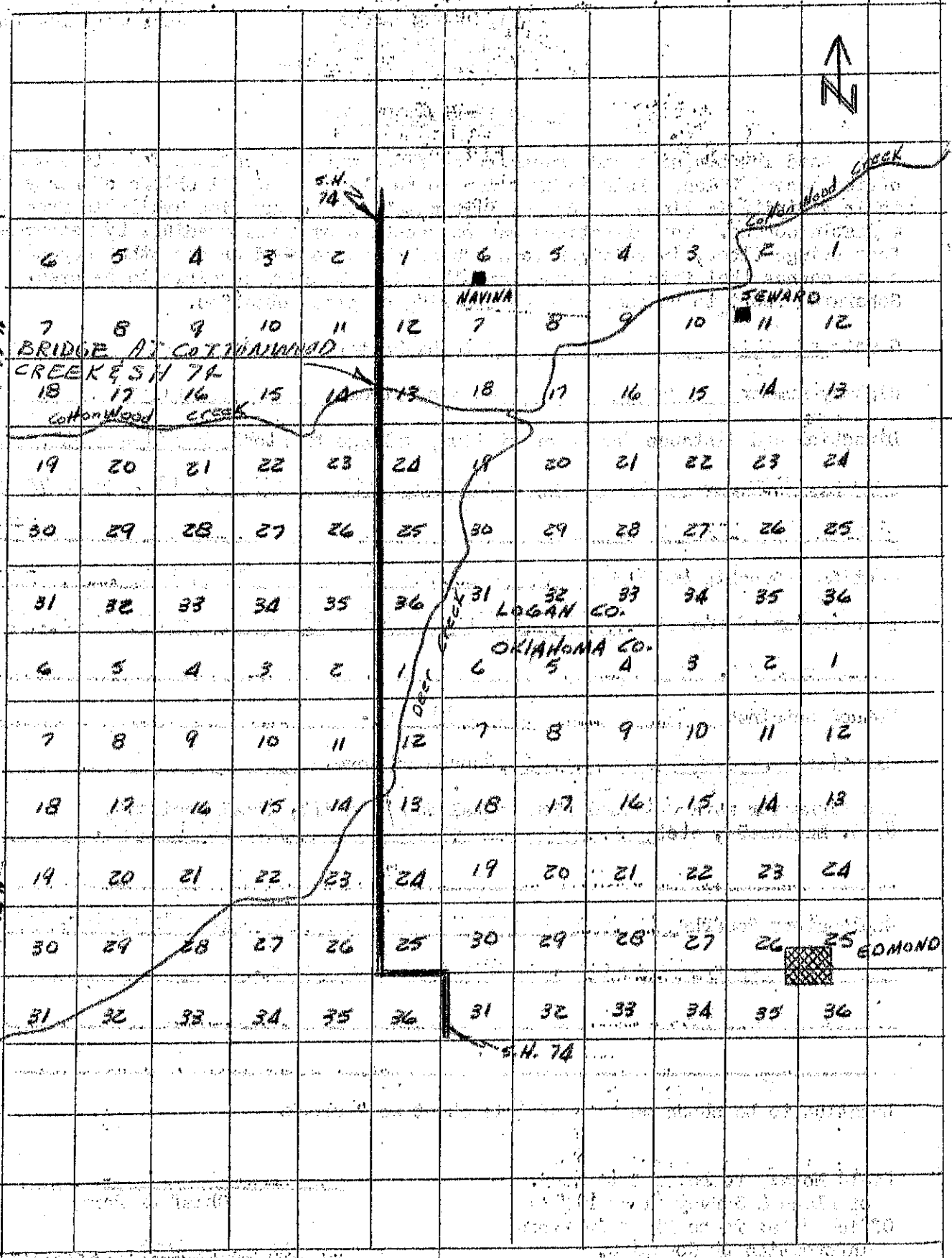
