FLOOD INFORMATION FORM

To be used in obtaining and transmitting flood water elevations for Plans & Survey office record files. This information to be obtained by all Chiefs of Party in their vicinity in times of unusual high water, or at any time available from a reliable source. The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

Direction and distance from nearest town, village or store 4 miles west of Adair

Section, Township and Range Between Sec. 25, T-23-N, R-18-E and Sec. 36, T-23-N, R-18-E.

Description of Location At Pryor Creek Concrete Bridge on E & W Sec. Line between Sec's 25 & 36, T-23-N, R-18-E - On SH 28, four miles west of Adair.

Method obtained Field Observation

Elevation 4.0 Ft. below West end Source of levels BM - Centerline Concrete floor, West end Pryor Creek Bridge. For USG & GS Level datum see SWO 2226 (1) - SH 28.  
Pryor Creek Bridge in Place.

Was highwater mark obtained from actual water, drift, Rogers, Mayes Co's. - Foyil to Adair.  
U. S. Engineers, etc? From water and silt marks left on bridge and etc. on Oct. 5, 1959  
after water had receded some.

Explanatory Remarks Hi-Water elevation obtained in the field on Oct. 5, 1959 by Rees Day Moran, Jr., Chief of Party and Gale Buck McMurphy, Rodman.  
Water slightly covered the road (SH 28) just east of the present Pryor Creek Bridge and caused some damage to present road bed.
