

Subject Highwater Information, Mayes & Delaware Counties



1. Transmitted with this letter 3 copies of S.D. Form 13 depicting highwater information in Pryor, Oklahoma that occurred on July 3, 1976.
2. I talked to several people in Pryor and they reported that between 3:30PM and 5:00PM 9 inches of rain fell. There was considerable more flood damage from this storm than from the September 18, 1975 flood. The people in the businesses that were flooded, were of the opinion that the culvert under the railroad was too small and caused the water to back up on them.
3. No other major highwater occurred in these areas that was of record proportion. In Salina, which is approx. 10 miles east of Pryor, they received only 3 inches of rain.
4. 0.5 day was spent by 2 men obtaining this information.
