FLOOD INFORMATION FORM

To be used in obtaining and transmitting flood water elevations for Plans & Survey office record files. This information to be obtained by all Chiefs of Party in their vicinity in times of unusual high water. The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

Direction and distance from nearest town, village or store 7.8 miles west of Wayne, 2.8 miles west Junction of SH 74 & SH 59, 0.2 miles east of Green's Store and Junction of SH 59 And SH 24

Section, Township and Range Between Sections 7 & 18 T-5- N, R-2-W

Description of Location Piles & Timber bridge across Fins Creek. This is a dredged channel at this point. High water Bench Mark set in 24" Cottonwood (60-D nail) on west bank of creek, 21' south of Center Line of road. Elev. 1.2' above center of road.

Method obtained Hugh S. Tennant party at bridge.

Was highwater mark obtained from actual water, drift, or local resident, explain Water Mark left of Power Pole was very clear.

Explanatory Remarks On June 1, 1947 this bridge was totally washed away. (Piers, stringers, floor, etc. all gone). Six inch rain this date. According to R.E. Gray, Rt. 1, Maysville, who lives 1 mi. east of bridge; this was highest water in 28 years.
