



October Flood Pattern Traced

This isohyetal map shows the record rainfall that struck the Enid area during the disastrous storm of Oct. 10-11 as prepared by John F. Sheridan, flash flood hydrologist with the National Weather Service River Forecast Center in Tulsa. Sheridan included the map in a letter of commendation to Pat Murphy for the service performed by Murphy and the KCRC staff in their broadcast of flood warnings and conditions throughout the night. The map shows that a segment of Enid just southeast of Market and Van Buren received a 20-inch rainfall that night.
