The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

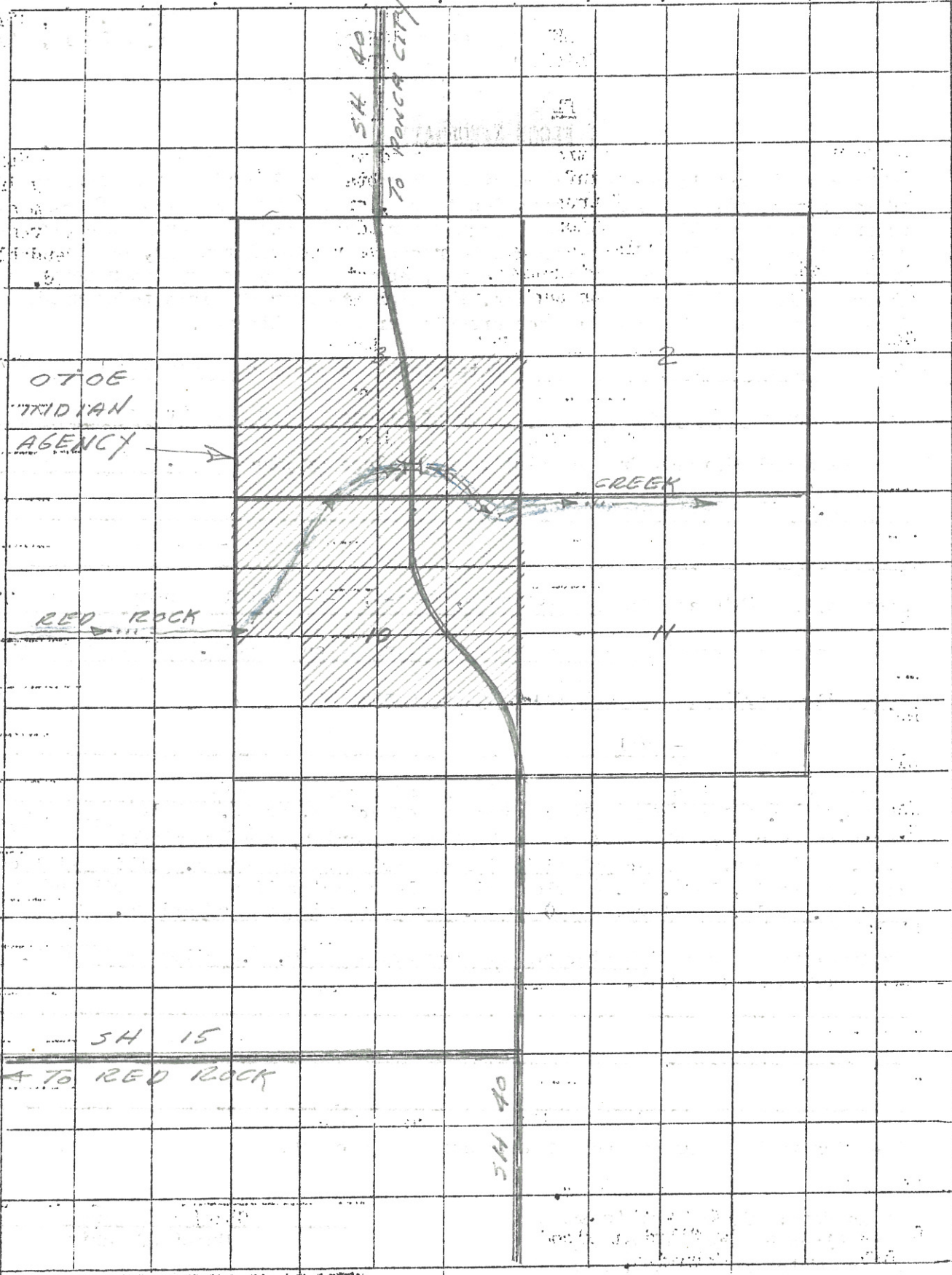
