FLOOD INFORMATION FORM

SURVEY DIVISION

To be used in obtaining and transmitting flood water elevations for Plans & Survey office record files. This information to be obtained by all Chiefs of Party in their vicinity in times of unusual high water, or at any time available from a reliable source. The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

County Nowata Date highwater occurred May 9, 1961

Highway number US 169 Name of stream California Creek

Direction and distance from nearest town, village or store Approximately 2 1/2 miles North of Nowata on US 169 present alignment.

Section, Township and Range On N & S Sec. line between Sec. 7 & 8, T-26-N, R-16-E.

Description of Location At the California Creek Section of the USED Cologah Dam re-location of US 169, approx. 2 1/2 miles north of Nowata.

Method obtained Wye Level) USCEGS

Elevation 2.5 ft below EM Source of levels EM = Centerline Conc. Floor Bridge, N. End, West Lane as described on back of this sheet.

Was highwater mark obtained from actual water, drift, local resident, U. S. Engineers, etc? Elevation obtained from silt marks on pavement after creek has subsided 1.5 feet. - Personnel: R. D. Moran, Jr., Chief of Party & C. J. Riley, Rodman.

Explanatory Remarks Traffic was not blocked, however there was approximately 0.5 foot water over the concrete paving north of the California Creek Bridge and also south of the bridge.

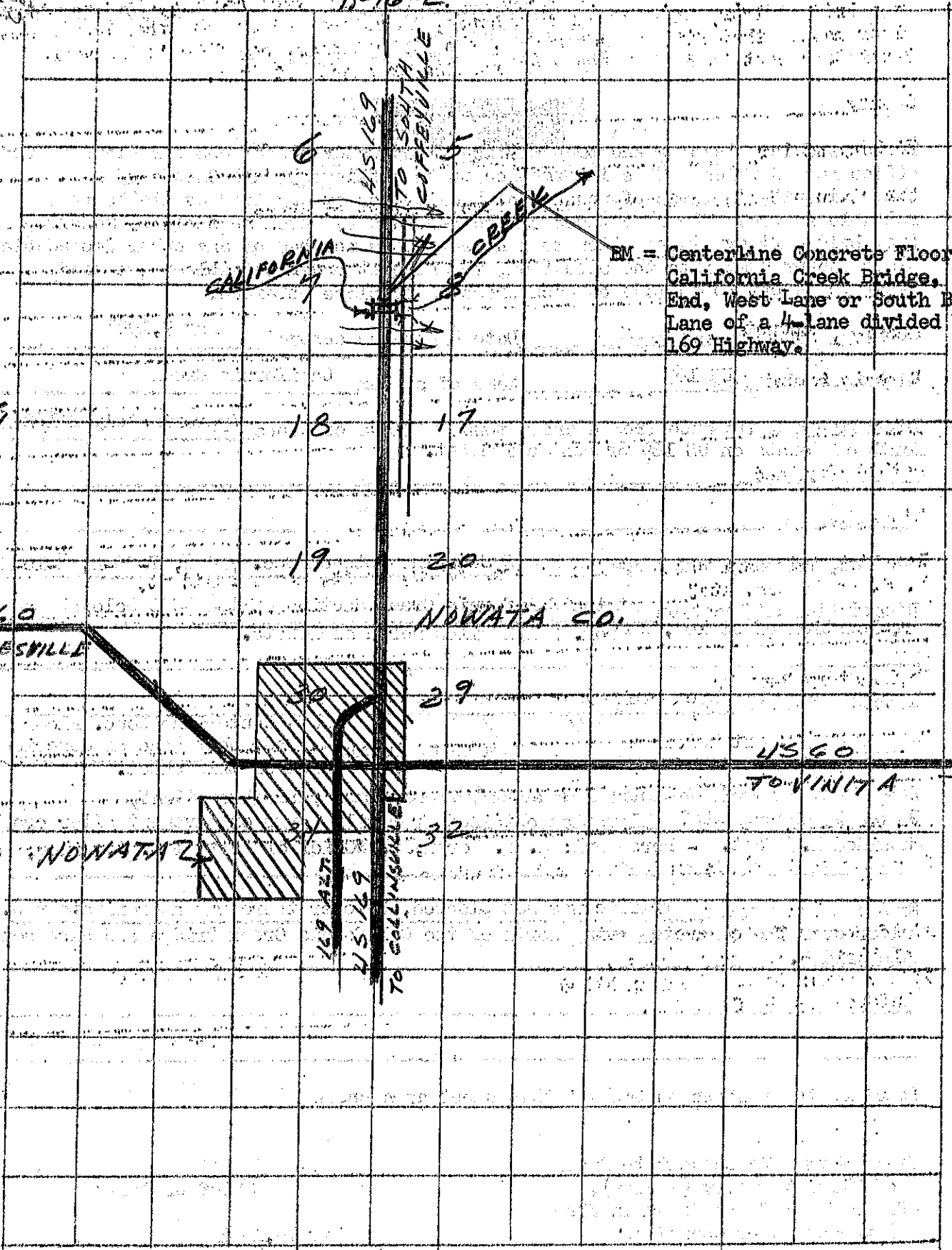
