This information to be obtained by all Chiefs of Party in their vicinity in times of unusual high water, or at any time available from a reliable source. The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

Was highwater mark obtained from actual water, drift, local resident, U. S. Engineers, etc? Information obtained through Mr. Co Neff, Box 213, Lenap, U.S. Dept. of Commerce, Weather Bureau, Tulsa.- Mr. Neff obtains and records data on the river gauge on present SH 10 bridge over the Verdigris River. - This information also checked by drift wood still in place.

Explanatory Remarks Present SH 10 was blocked by High Water both east and west of the bridge from traffic.
