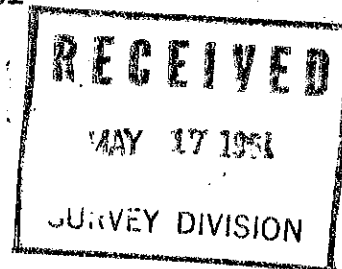

SH 11, South of Skiatook, Hominy Creek



		-5.06	98.82 Elev. of highwater backed up or overflowing from Bird Creek. Marks on fence post.
