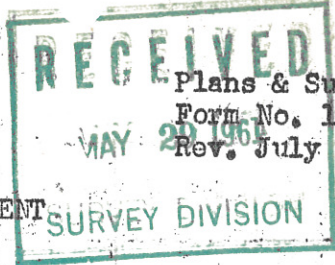

FLOOD INFORMATION FORM

To be used in obtaining and transmitting flood water elevations for Plans & Survey office record files. This information to be obtained by all Chiefs of Party in their vicinity in times of unusual high water, or at any time available from a reliable source. The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

County Ottawa Date highwater occurred May 19, 1961 Highway number US 66 Name of stream Has no name, is drain at west edge of Afton, on approx W. boundary line of original townsite. Direction and distance from nearest town, village or store In Afton

Section, Township and Range Sec. 32, T-26-N, R-22-E. Description of Location At a culvert at the west edge of the original townsite of Afton where present US 66 crosses the west original townsite boundary line.

Method obtained Wye Level 783.5 1.8 ft. above W. end Culv. BM = Centerline paving west end conc. Elevation concrete paving, (BM) Source of levels Culv. (as described above for location) USCGS Level Datum 783.5 Was highwater mark obtained from actual water, drift, local resident, U. S. Engineers, etc? Water & Silt marks after water had subsided some. Personnel: A. W. Opela, Rodman & C. E. Miller, Rodman.

Explanatory Remarks This hi-water occurred after heavy rains and the drainage ditch west of the culvert towards the railroad unable to carry the water mainly due to the RR bridge being too small, also the present culvert on US 66 being too small. Horse Creek at the N. Edge of Afton was not bank full at this time. Traffic was blocked at this culvert.

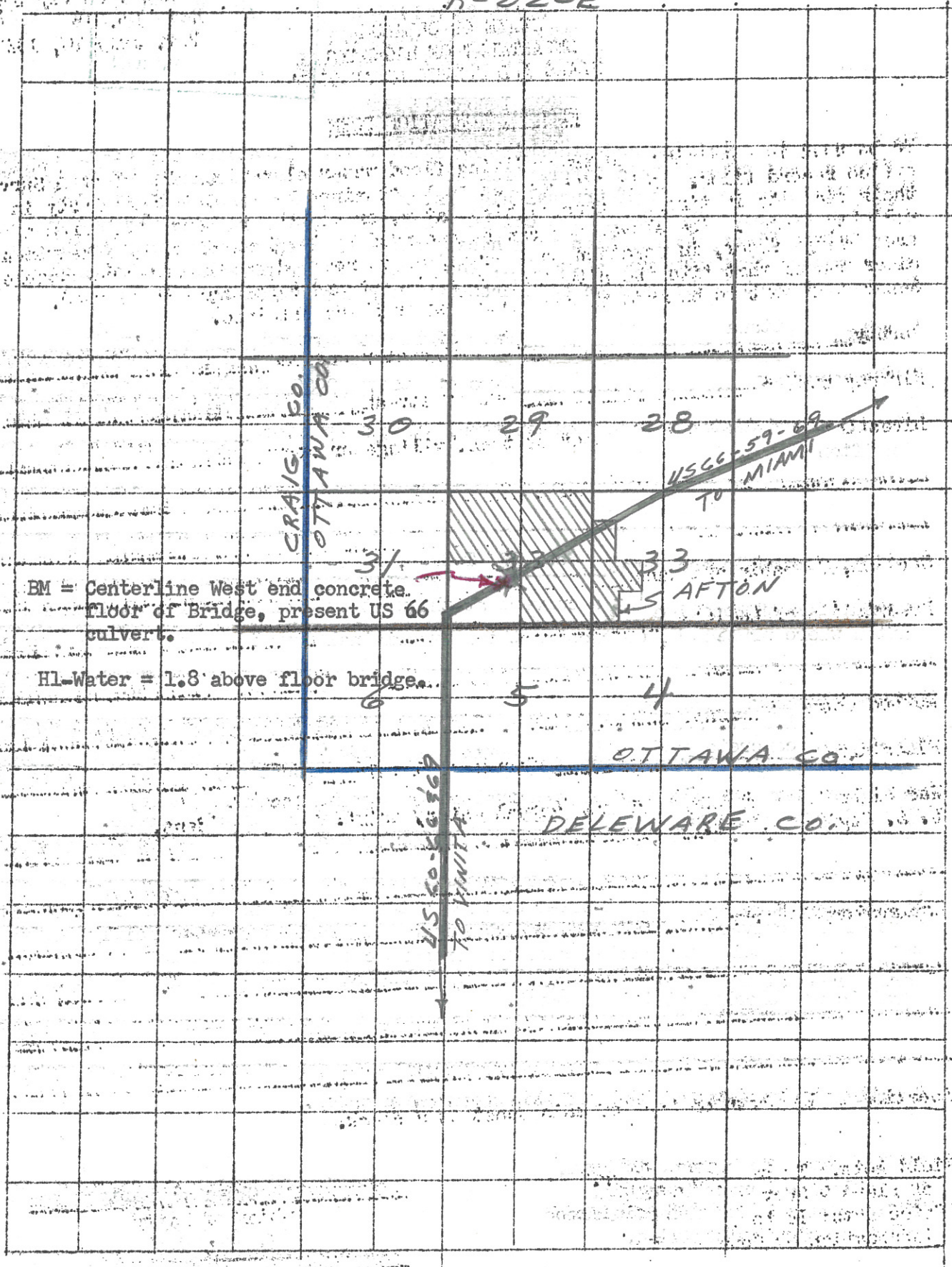
