Dear Mr. Vaughan:

Reference is made to your letter of 16 June 1949 regarding highwater elevations on the Cimarron River near Perkins. Records in this office show the maximum highwater elevation at the Cimarron river bridge south of Perkins, Oklahoma to be 835.18 feet above M.S.L. (May 19, 1949). A high-water mark in the vicinity indicates that the flood of October 1926 was at approximately elevation 836.9.

Your information regarding the river gage is appreciated.
