FLOOD INFORMATION FORM

To be used in obtaining and transmitting flood water elevations for Plans & Survey office record files. This information to be obtained by all Chiefs of Party in their vicinity in times of unusual high water, or at any time available from a reliable source. The elevations can be recorded by level readings, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear runner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.
