Subject SWO 2406 (1) - US 169 - Tulsa-Rogers-Nowata Co's. - Relocation of US 169 from approximately 1 mile northeast of Owasso, northeasterly by Collinsville and west of Cologah, thence through Talala to 1.5 miles north of Watova.

Additional Information - Section 2 - Caney River crossing at Sta. 919+31
High-water data.

This is to advise that on August 15, 1961 the high water elevation on Caney River reached an elevation of 595.9 feet. This elevation obtained in the field just after the water started subsiding. This elevation obtained on centerline survey at approximate station 912+66 on the south side of the river.

This high water was caused by local heavy rains and heavy rains up stream.

Level datum used for this high water elevation is U.S.C. & G.S. "Mean Sea Level" and is identical to level datum of the original survey of SWO 2406 (1).

Section 2 this survey was completed on January 23, 1961.
