FLOOD INFORMATION FORM

To be used in obtaining and transmitting flood water elevations for Plans & Survey office record files. This information to be obtained by all Chiefs of Party in their vicinity in times of unusual high water, or at any time available from a reliable source. The elevations can be recorded by level reading, by measurement from bridge floor, in relation to a house, above roadbed or any other dependable, clear manner that fits the situation, the highest order possible to be used. Separate report to be made on each crossing or place obtained.

County Sequoyah Date highwater occurred April 3, 1957

Highway number US 64 Name of stream Sallisaw Creek

Direction and distance from nearest town, village or store 3 miles West of Sallisaw on US 64.

Section, Township and Range Between Section 3, T-11-N, R-23-E and Section 34, T-12-N, R-23-E.

Description of Location Just west of Concrete bridge over Sallisaw Creek. There is a concrete dam across Sallisaw Creek, approximately 600 feet North of present US 64 concrete bridge over Sallisaw Creek, which is the main water supply to the town of Sallisaw.

Method obtained Wye Level -

Elevation 4.4 below B.M. Source of levels B.M. - Centerline Paving, East end present concrete paving on Sallisaw creek bridge.

Was highwater mark obtained from actual water, drift, local resident, U. S. Engineers, etc? Actual Water, observed in the field by myself and L. J. Yates Instrumentman on this party.

Explanatory Remarks This Hi-Water occurred after a 3" rain during the night of April 2, 1957, accompanied by hail and tornado weather.

Elevation Hi-Water = 4.4 ft below centerline concrete floor bridge Elev., East end bridge and present concrete bridge over Sallisaw Creek on Present US 64. There was 0.4 ft water over present US 64 through a low swag in present paving west of present bridge.
