# Further develop rapid assessment tools, habitat and subreach evaluations

- Gina Dello Russo passed around the following article as information regarding rapid assessment, habitat, and subreach evaluations.
  - Merrit, D. and Bateman, H. (2012) Linking stream flow and ground water to avian habitat in a desert riparian system. Ecological Applications. 22(7): 1973-1988.
- The workgroup discussed possibly harvesting and planting on a site that has already been permitted with little or no funding to demonstrate rapid assessment in action.
- Rapid assessment of Mesohabitat for the Rio Grande Silvery Minnow was discussed.
   HRW is interested in seeing if:
  - Using aerial photography of USGS study sites (matching dates of measurements to the greatest degree possible) digitize in-channel features based on observable differences and interpretation.
  - Determine what degree of accuracy is possible from these interpretation based on USGS measured features.
  - Utilizing remote sensing data, evaluate the potential for distinguishing in-channel features at various flows. Again use USGS measured flows and river locations to test potential accuracy in interpretation.
